FOUR ELMS HILL – ROAD REPAIRS AND RESURFACING

I am writing to advise you that the works detailed above have unfortunately had to be delayed by one week due to unforeseen traffic management issues.

A full road closure of Four Elms Hill (Grain Bound) will be required on Sunday 2nd August 2020 between 1.00am and 8.00am, with the diversion being via Upnor Road leading to Chattenden Lane to enable the Traffic Management for the scheme to be installed safely. A detailed diversion plan is attached. The works to Four Elms Hill will take place on Sunday 2nd August 2020 for 3 weeks with all traffic diverted through the layby and should expect delays.

Vehicles will not be able to stop or park in the layby for the duration of the works and will be towed away if this were to happen.

Once the works are complete we will once again require a full night time road closure of Four Elms Hill (Grain bound) to remove the traffic management safely and as above the diversion plan is attached.

These works are being undertaken as part of Medway Councils commitment to maintaining and improving the Highway Network. Further details of the Council's Annual Highway Improvement Programme can be found on the Council's website at www.medway.gov.uk/resurfacing

Information boards erected on site will be amended to suit this update.

As mentioned before, whilst carrying out this essential works, our contractor will implement special measures and take extra precautions to keep our workforce safe in line with COVID-19 requirements. These include, but are not limited to, additional welfare facilities being provided on site and the provision of personal protective equipment such as cleansing products to our workforce colleagues. We will also adhere to social distancing requirements as much as is practically possible as part of our working practices.
